

WEEK 3 INSTRUCTOR LESSON PLAN

1. Opening prayer and Devotional presented by the instructor. Use a devotional thought that illustrates the theme of witnessing/ testifying.
2. Pass out handouts.
3. Instructors are encouraged to share their personal stories about witnessing. However, before beginning finish last weeks discussion on discipleship by using the lecture DISCIPLE. In week two we shared about the differences between a disciple and a believer, but this lecture on DISCIPLE clearly defines a disciple. Place the word DISCIPLE on the board and have the students participate by reading the Bible verses. After the lecture on DISCIPLE play the two radio sermons. While the radio sermons are playing the Instructors can review student homework.
4. Listen to radio sermon “Jesus Loves a Condemned World,” and “Going with Jesus.”
5. Continue in class with the second lecture by placing upon the white board the word TESTIFY” Place the word TESTIFY on board and ask students to look up each Bible verse and read it to the class. Share each letter and discuss. While presenting this lecture the instructor is encouraged to share in class their own personal witnessing experiences.
6. Review homework assignment and remind them of memory verse John 12:46 for week 4.
7. Closing prayer.
